

Summer Enrichment Program 2025

We are excited to announce our 2025 Summer Enrichment Program offerings. This Summer we are all about creating a FUN experience for children as we incorporate an informative, multi-sensory approach to education in each week's themed events.

Our enrichment program focuses on supporting socialization through small group activities and games. Activities are introduced through centers with a mix of child directed, and teacher directed activities. We will also include outdoor games, fun physical challenges, along with a special visit each week from a local performer or vendor. See weekly themes for more information.

Program Options:

Toddlers: 15 months to 2.11 years old

Designed for children who are currently in our toddler program or joining our toddler program in the fall.

Preschoolers Mixed Age: 3 Years Old to 5 Years Old

Designed for children 3 years old through kindergarten. <u>Must be 3 years old by the start of their summer session.</u>

Summer Enrichment Program Schedule:

Program Hours: 8:30 -11:30 Monday-Friday

Drop Off: 8:30-8:40 Pick Up: 11:20-11:30

Extended day: Please note we do not offer an extended day program during summer enrichment. There will be a \$1 per minute late fee for parents who pick up after class hours.

Tuition Rates and Payments:

Toddler Tuition: \$290 per week.

Preschool Tuition: \$260 per week.

Payment is due in full at the time of registration. We do not hold spots without payment in full. After your registration has been approved you will receive an invoice by email with your tuition fee.

Payments can be made online via the **ProCare** parent portal by credit card (2.45% fee applies), by cash or check.

* <u>Registrations will be removed due to non-payment after 1 week.</u>

Registration & Forms:

Lilliput families can register on our ProCare parent portal (<u>www.myprocare.com</u>) starting on February 11th and the public can register starting March 11th. Space is limited and on a first come first serve basis.

Returning families can simply log into their ProCare account, go to Alerts, the Registrations Available tab, where they can select their desired summer weeks and fill out the required registration forms.

New families should start by going to www.lilliputschool.com and click the **Step 1** link on our registration page. Once imported into the system you can then access registration.

A current school health/camp form is required before their first day. Ask your child's pediatrician for a School/Sport Health Form which should include the date of their last physical, immunizations, and a clearance to participate in all activities.

Registration Confirmation:

After your registration has been imported into ProCare the class status will change from Pending to Approved. Parents will receive an invoice for the weeks they registered (due upon receipt), and a link to an Orientation PowerPoint which will cover our policies and procedures in more depth.

Medication/Allergies/Wellness:

If your child has an EpiPen for allergies and/or will require medication during our summer program, you must drop off the medication in person **prior to their first day**. Medication must be delivered in the original container. The required paperwork must accompany the medication when you drop it off. Please see the Medication Box on our Summer Enrichment page for the required forms or message the office.



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We follow our school year wellness policy for when sick children should stay home sick from school. If your child has a fever, cough (more than 5 per hour), an unidentified rash or has had a bout of vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours they should stay home from school. If you are in doubt, please call and speak to the office.

Cancellation/Refunds/Absences:

As we plan our staffing around our enrollment, we cannot offer refunds for any reason unless the class is cancelled due to low enrollment. We **CANNOT** offer makeup days as spaces are extremely limited.

If your child will be absent, please call 508-842-0430 or email <u>info@lilliputschool.com</u> to let us know they will be absent. If your child misses' school due to illness we are not able to provide a refund or credit for the lost tuition. Summer Tuition is non-refundable and nontransferable.
