

# Kindergarten Curriculum Checklist

### Math Skills:

- Name and identify basic shapes,
- Draw basic shapes
- Tell me the hour
- Count by 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's to 100,
- Write numbers 0-10, 11-20, and 1-100
- Recognize numbers 0-10/11-20, and 1-100,
- Sequence by size, by number, and events
- Complete a pattern
- Understand one-to-one correspondence with increasing difficulty
- Match numbers to objects 0-10\_\_, 11-20\_\_

- Identify the concepts more, less and equal
- Understand the symbols <, > and =
- Correctly use a number line
- Use manipulatives to add and subtract
- Read and make a relevant graph
- Identify a penny, nickel, dime, and a quarter
- Discuss money value
- Compare lengths
- Write numbers 1-100 in order
- Measure to the inch

## Writing Skills and Fine Motor Skills

- Hold a pencil appropriately for writing
- Color with control and care
- Use a proper grasp on scissors and can manipulate them well
- Neatly write the alphabet in sequential order
- Form upper and lower case printed letters
- Use appropriate spaces between words when writing
- Use appropriate spaces between letters when writing
- Write original sentences using inventive spelling
- Use capital letters at the beginning of a sentence
- Use a period at the end of a sentence

## **Reading Readiness:**

- Recognize all the color words (rd, or, yl, gr, bl, pr, pk, bk, br and gr)
- Recognize all the uppercase letters
- Recognize all the lowercase letters
- Hear and Identify sounds at the beginning, middle, end
- Hear ending sounds at the end of a word
- Hear two letter blends and name the symbol
- Hear digraph ch, sh, th, qu and wh
- Hear short vowels and can name the symbol

- Blend cvc words (consonant vowel consonant)
- Blend other combinations (cvcc, ccvc, etc)
- Understand the concepts of rhyming and antonyms
- Listen to a story and retell it or give specific details
- Find the correct picture to match with the sentence read
- Read a simple sentence
- Recognize 17 sight word
